Please Note:

- 1. Your ward's uniform should be just the right size- neither too small nor oversized.
- 2. Girls must wear a plain Navy Blue cotton hair band in case of shorthair or make two plaits with Navy Blue ribbons in summer & Maroon in winters.
- 3. Sikh boys are required to wear navy blue Patka/Turban in summers and Maroon Patka / Turban in winter.
- 4. It is compulsory for Sikh boys to wear Turban from class VIII onwards.

Disciplinary Action:

The school is very particular about encouraging and promoting good values and etiquettes. Incase, any child is found using abusive words, signs or language he/ she would be dealt severely. The school has a right to take strict action against the child. Punishment and heavy fine will be levied.

School Dues

- Last dates for depositing the fee for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarter are 10th April, 10th July, 10th October and 10th January respectively. No reminder will be sent for the same. A late fee fine of Rs. 50/- per day shall be levied after the lapse of the last date of the receipt of fee each quarter. No applications with regard to omission of fine will be entertained. Parents are requested not to approach the Principal regarding late fee fine.
- If a student fails to pay the School dues for 30 days from the date, his/her name will be struck off from the school rolls. The child will then have to be re-admitted after seeking approval from the Principal, having made full payment of the school dues and fine.
- If there will be any fee outstanding at the closing of academic year, the Progress Report will not be issued.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Parents, please note the following:

- No student, once in school would be allowed to leave during working hours. Prior sanction, at least a day in advance has to be taken for any such leave. No half day leave application would be entertained.
- We do not accept any item sent during working hours due to security reasons and also to inculcate a sense of responsibility in the students.
- No gifts are allowed on birthdays. You may send two toffees per child if desired. Anything other than this will be sent back.
- It has been noticed that in the race against time every morning, most of the students are missing out on their 'Breakfast' which is one of the most important meals of the day. The result is increasing number of children reporting to the school's Sick Room, complaining of stomach ache and nausea. We, therefore have a short 'Fruit Break' daily for the students. They are required to bring any one Fruit/Fruit Salad everyday and eat it during the break.
- **Monday Special** To encourage the child to eat everything, the school specifies the tiffin for Mondays. Kindly follow the same to help us develop good eating habits in your child.
- 'Show and Tell' days are followed where the child is expected to bring his/her favorite toy/book/picture or anything else and tell then classmates about it. This helps the child become more confident and interactive.
- Wednesdays are observed as 'Activity Days' for classes Playway to Prep II wherein children are allowed to come in their casuals clothes.
