Sub:- Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 of Right of children to free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of Right of children to free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the inspection report of your school dated and correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant of educational recognition to Apollo Public School, Gharuan, Patiala for class I to Class VIII till 31-3-2023.

The above sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. Sanction for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any application to recognize/affiliate beyond class VIII.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of children to free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure 1) and Right of children to free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011 (Annexure II).
3. The School Shall Admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and the disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.

Provided, that in case of pre-primary classes also, this form shall be followed.

4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per sub-section 2 of the section of the 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursement, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child of his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission-
 - (a) to any child for lack of age proof; or

- (i) such a teacher is entitled to receive payment for the services rendered for the period for which he is engaged;
- (ii) the ground or reason, and at each place of birth of any of those reasons;
- (iii) the date of birth;
- (iv) the place where such a teacher is born, and the date of birth;
- (v) the conditions of elementary education, which may not be subjected to physical punishment of mental torture;
- (vi) the name, address, and other particulars of the teacher;
- (vii) every child receiving elementary education shall be provided with a certificate of birth right (CL);
- (viii) provision of students with auxiliary / special needs as per provisions of RTI;
- (ix) the teachers are entitled with minimum qualifications, as laid under subsection (3) of section 25, provided that the existing teachers who, at the time of commencement of the Act, do not possess the minimum qualifications, shall acquire such qualifications within a period of 5 years from the date of commencement of the Act;
- (x) the teachers perform their duties, specified under subsection(3) of 24, of the Act; and
- (xi) the teachers shall not engage himself or herself in any private activities;
- (xii) the school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by the concerned authority;
- (xiii) the school shall award students' assignments to the norms and standards specified in the school as specified in section 19 of the Act;
- (xiv) the school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The figures recorded at the time of last inspection, if any, are to be given;

15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.

17. The school furnishes such reports and information, as may be required by the Director or District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/Local Authority, as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
